

With double digit unemployment, the National Association of Letter Carriers (NALC) National Food Drive comes at a critical time. Food banks are seeing an unprecedented crisis as requests have risen 20-25% for each of the past six months while donations continue to decrease.

The NALC food drive works in partnership with the AFL-CIO Community Services network, United Way Worldwide, and the nation's food bank network. All citizens need to do is place a box or can of non-perishable food next to their mailbox before the letter carrier delivers mail on Saturday, May 8th. The carrier will do the rest. The food is taken back to a postal station, sorted and delivered by union volunteers to area food banks or pantries for needy families to access.
